discovered here, from the Uffizi and Galleria dell'Accademia to the Ponte Vecchio, or alternatively you may visit the majestic Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore and Basilica di Santa Croce.

Enchanting Lucca is situated on the banks of the River Serchio, where the cobbled streets, handsome piazzas and shady promenades make it a perfect destination to explore by foot, as is Pisa, where the city's most famous symbol, the precarious Leaning Tower, appears before you in the Square of Miracles.

### ISLANDS OF THE MIDDLE SEA

On Elba, the island where Napoleon Bonaparte was exiled, you will see the elaborate villa where he lived, or take an optional tour to Capoliveri to enjoy some local wine. You'll then

cruise the Isles Lavezzi and Maddalena Archipelago en route to Bonifacio and Ajaccio on the island of Corsica, ancestral home of Napoleon, before continuing through what was once known as the Middle Sea to explore the capital of Menorca, Mahon, and the bustling city of Palma de Mallorca.

### SAILING SOUTHERN SPAIN

After a day at sea, enjoy a panoramic drive through some of the outstanding sites of Malaga to visit the Picasso Museum, or an optional full day in Granada, where the Alhambra, begun in 1238, was the last capital of the Moors in Spain. Your excursion here includes the Royal Palace and the Generalife with its splendid gardens.

The Rock of Gibraltar in the mouth of the Mediterranean is a tiny slice of Britishness full of extraordinary history. Then arrive in Cadiz for a morning tour of the 18th-century Baroque cathedral and the splendid Moorish-style Alameda de Apodaca gardens. Or you may travel to Jerez de la Frontera, a town famous for the production of sherry where, after a tour of the city, there will be some sherry-tasting at a renowned Bodega.



### RIVER CRUISING TO SEVILLE

*Aegean Odyssey* then sails inland through the Andalusian countryside along the Guadalquivir River to dock in the heart of Seville. Here you will visit the Royal Palace Alcazar, the oldest residence of Spanish royalty that is still in use today. The building amalgamates influences from the Arabic period and the late Middle Ages, through to the Renaissance, Baroque and the nineteenth century. In Cordoba, one of the world's great destinations, you'll also visit one of the wonders of the medieval world, the Great Mosque.
