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ATHENS & ANCIENT GREECE

Your two-night hotel stay in Athens includes a full morning's guided tour of the city's ancient citadel, the Acropolis, which represents the most magnificent achievements of Athenian culture. You will also visit the wonderful Acropolis Museum and have some free time to explore the city's other remarkable sites such as the National Archaeological Museum.

Your three-day tour of Classical Greece starts with the medieval Monastery of *Osios Loukas*, which contains some truly remarkable Byzantine mosaics and frescoes. Then to ancient Delphi at the foot of Mount Parnassus, for a guided tour of these fabulous remains, including the Temple of Apollo, which dates

from 330BC. During your time here, walk the Sacred Way, following in the footsteps of thousands of pilgrims who came to consult the Oracle. For the final part of your land tour you will then visit Mycenae, the capital of a civilisation which dominated the eastern Mediterranean from the 16th to the 13th centuries BC, followed by the ruins of Epidaurus, where the magnificent theatre is still in use today.

SANTORINI & CRETE

Boarding *Aegean Odyssey*, your cruise begins with Santorini, where the newly reopened Minoan settlement of Akrotiri is a highlight. The island also has some splendid picture-postcard villages to see, including the whitewashed houses and famously blue-domed churches of Oia.

Arrive in Heraklion, the capital of Crete, for a panoramic tour through the city and some free time for a stroll, before moving to the unique village of Arolithos, which has been designed to recreate life on the island as it would have been in centuries past. Here you will enjoy a traditional Greek Easter lunch, accompanied by an entertaining folklore show.

Agios Nikolaos, overlooking the beautiful curve of Mirabello Bay, is your starting point for another pleasant journey into the Cretan countryside. Along the way stop at the medieval Eastern Orthodox Keras Monastery, then arrive at the village of Seli for refreshments at a local tavern and some breathtaking views of the Lasithi Plateau, which is filled with hundreds of picturesque windmills.

CRUISING THE DODECANESE

Leaving Crete behind, sail to the friendly island of Karpathos, which has managed to maintain many of its customs and idiosyncrasies due to its remoteness. Then arrive in Rhodes, where the structure of the capital's old town dates from the era of the Knights of St John of Jerusalem, who lived here from 1309 until 1522. You will also see the lookout Mount Smith, so



named after the British admiral Sir Sydney Smith, or visit Lindos for a walk around one of Rhodes' most stunning coastal towns.

ISLAND GEMS OF THE SOUTHERN AEGEAN

Greek mythology has it that the island of Nisyros was once a part of Kos, until Poseidon threw a piece of the island at the giant Polybotes, trapping his foe and creating a volcano. Then step ashore on Delos, birthplace of Achilles and one of the most interesting archaeological sites in Greece, before relaxing in the cafes and shops of beautiful Mykonos.
