ANDALUSIAN CITIES AND RIVER CRUISING

During your two-night stay in Seville, you will visit the Royal Palace Alcazar, the oldest residence of Spanish royalty still in use today which features an extraordinary array of architectural influences, from the Arabic period right up to the 19th century. Alternatively, enjoy a themed tour featuring tapas sampling.

The Cathedral of Seville is the third largest Gothic church in Europe and houses the tomb of Christopher Columbus – well worth a visit in your free time. Enjoy a full day of sightseeing in Cordoba, which contains one of the wonders of the medieval world, the Great Mosque. Before sailing, you'll enjoy a fabulous Flamenco dance show on board.

IBERIAN HIGHLIGHTS

There has been a settlement on the site of Lisbon since Neolithic times and the city has long played a key role in European history. This rich past is evident during your tour of the oldest Alfama quarter, the monumental statue of Christ the King, and the monastery of Jeronimos. Then in Oporto, visit a wine estate to sample that most famous of fortified wines, port, or join a tour of this charming and historic city.

It is believed by the faithful that St James the Apostle preached in Galicia and that, after his death in the Holy Land, his body was brought back to Santiago de Compostela. In the 11th century a church was built

over his remains and has been a place of pilgrimage ever since. Alternatively, you may enjoy a panoramic boat tour along the bay of Vigo to taste some world-renowned Galician mussels and white wine.

A TASTE OF FRANCE – BORDEAUX AND LA ROCHELLE

Aegean Odyssey then cruises up the River Gironde to berth in the heart of Bordeaux, where the magnificent 18th-century architecture has led



many people to describe the city as having the most beautiful streets in France. Highlights here include the Palais Rohan and the 13th-century Cathedral of St Andrew, with a choice of tours also available taking you to the Wine Museum or out of the city for some wine and food tasting at a prestigious estate.

Cruising north along the southwest coast of France, you'll arrive at the delightful port of La Rochelle for a tour of the city's historic sites, including one of the jewels of the Atlantic coast, Ile de Re, which is connected to the mainland by a bridge nearly two miles in length.

GUERNSEY AND NORMANDY

A busy port since Roman times, the picturesque town of St Peter Port in

Guernsey is filled with cobblestone streets that are lined with Regency buildings. Guarding the port is the 13th century Castle Cornet, which also houses a number of interesting museums.

HISTORIC LONDON

Your cruise holiday ends with a 2-night hotel stay in the British capital. A scenic guided tour of London starts with a cruise down the majestic River Thames from Tower Bridge to Westminster Bridge. Then an orientation drive including Westminster Abbey and a stop at Buckingham Palace. There is also plenty of free time for you to visit your favourite museum or simply head for the shops.
