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LONDON TO THE REMOTE SHETLAND ISLANDS

A 2-night hotel stay in the British capital with included sightseeing precedes our departure from Tilbury as *Aegean Odyssey* heads north for Scotland. With two days at sea there's plenty of time to get to know the ship and take in a lecture or two, before your arrival in Lerwick, the capital of the Shetlands. As well as seeing the famous free roaming ponies, you may also discover the remarkable archaeological site of Jarlshof, tour Scotland's most northerly town, or visit Lerwick Castle.

ICELAND: LAND OF MYTHS AND LEGENDS

The tiny island of Heimaey is your first port of call in Iceland. Heimaey

was devastated by the eruption of the Eldfell volcano in 1973, which destroyed over 400 buildings and deposited 200 million tons of ash and lava on the landscape. Here you will explore its rich history and natural beauty on a relaxing walking tour to the remains of Fort Skansinn, built in the 17th century to protect the Vestmannaeyjar islands.

Then on to Iceland's vibrant capital Reykjavik, where the Arbær open-air museum boasts more than 20 historic buildings, most of which have been relocated from central Reykjavik to form a town square, a village and a farm. Alternatively, you may bathe in the healing, tranquil waters of the Blue Lagoon, or take an optional journey along the famous "Golden Circle" to the tumultuous Gullfoss waterfall and the other

worldly landscapes of the Thingvellir National Park, Iceland's most important historical site and an area of outstanding natural beauty.

After calling at the remote town of Isafjordur on the edge of the Arctic Circle, *Aegean Odyssey* cruises to Akureyri on the north coast under snowcapped peaks at the head of Iceland's longest fjord. Here, signs of the earth's power – glaciers, volcanoes, lava fields and stacks of basalt – are everywhere. Perhaps take in Iceland's marvellous birdlife on Lake Myvatn, one of Iceland's natural treasures. Myvatn, with its bubbling mud pools, extraordinary lava formations, volcanic craters and birdlife, is Iceland as you have always imagined it. Next, Iceland's wildlife takes centre stage as *Aegean*

Odyssey continues to the pretty fishing town of Husavik, the island's whale-watching centre.

FAROE AND ORKNEY ISLANDS

Setting course south, we call in at the small but charming capital of the Faroe Islands, Torshavn. Torshavn means 'Thor's Harbour', named after the god of thunder and lightning in Norse mythology. Founded in the 10th century, it is considered to be one of the oldest capitals in Northern Europe. Kirkwall, the capital of the Orkney Islands, is close to many fascinating Stone Age sites. Here you will visit the Neolithic village of Skara Brae and the ancient Ring of Brodgar, or perhaps visit the beautiful hand-painted Italian Chapel of the South Isles.



ROYAL EDINBURGH

Arriving at the port of Rosyth in the morning, there's an included visit to nearby Edinburgh, Scotland's magnificent capital. You'll see the Royal Mile and visit the famous Palace of Holyroodhouse, the residence of The Queen when she visits Scotland. Alternatively, head for Stirling Castle and enter the world of Scotland's Renaissance Kings and Queens.
